Notice is hereby given that sealed bids for providing material, equipment, and labor for **Project No. CP1141000 "PARTRIDGE LIFT STATION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT"**, will be received at the Garden Grove City Clerk's Office at 11222 Acacia Parkway, Garden Grove, CA 92840. Engineer's estimate on this project is around \$380,000 dollars.

The intent of this project is to provide improvements at the Garden Grove Sanitary District's (District) Partridge Lift Station. The project site is located near the Thunderbird Mobile Home Parks, at 13160 Partridge Street, Garden Grove, CA. These improvements are for the installation of a grinder to the station's influent sewer and converting the existing SCE electrical service to three-phase power. The main scope of work is as follows:

- Coordinate with SCE and install new transformer, conduit, meter pedestal, and wires for new 120/240 Volt, 3-phase service. Coordinate removal of existing single phase service, and perform all work required for removal.

- Grinder Installation and Manhole Improvements, which includes installing the grinder; widening the channel; raising the shelf; coating the inside of the manhole; removal of manhole eccentric cone and installation of manhole flat top; and installing a composite manhole frame and cover with cover lock.

- Electrical Work, which includes but is not limited to installing new Service Meter Pedestal and conduit with wire to new transfer switch; conduit and splice box for the Grinder's power cable; replacing generator with new 30 kW, 120/240 volt, 3-phase natural gas generator; remove existing single phase electrical equipment; replace existing automatic transfer switch; install new Channel Monster Control Panel; remove existing wire and equipment in the existing pump station electrical enclosure and pump control panel; and install new wire and equipment required for 3 phase operation as shown on the Contract Drawings.

- SCADA system integration of new alarm and status signals into the District's existing system is to be performed by the District's integrator Alice Choi with Control Automation Design Inc., as a subcontractor to the General Contractor. **No exceptions to this requirement** will be accepted. Control Automation Design may be contacted at (213) 219-0655.

- Removal and replacement of existing concrete slabs, generator base and chain link fence at the pump station site to facilitate upgrades to the station.

- Installation, operation, and maintenance of a temporary pump station by-passing during construction.

- Modification of the existing chain link fence surrounding the pump station.

Contractors who are interested in the site visit shall sign up for a 15-minute time slot by 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, September 23, 2020, by sending an email to ljin@gg-city.org. The site-visit will be held on a pre-determined date set by the City. City staff will be available to answer site specific questions during the visit.
