A request for Site Plan approval to expand the existing Hyundai car dealership showroom and service center. The remodel will include enclosing and expanding the existing open-air drive-up area; expanding the showroom and customer service building; adding a new approximately 700 square foot vehicle pick-up canopy; and remodeling the building's existing facade.
