Proposed Project: The proposed zoning text amendment would allow wider driveways for properties developed or proposed to be developed with an Accessory Dwelling unit. The total driveway width for such properties can be up to five feet wider than the maximum allowed (approximately 30 feet) per Section 17.300.020(D)(2) of the Westminster Municipal Code. The wider driveway will facilitate the parking of an additional vehicle.

Environmental Review Status: The proposed project has been reviewed pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and has been found to be exempt per Class 5 (Section 15305 for Minor Alterations in Land Use Regulations per the CEQA Guidelines). The project makes minor changes to residential parking layout standards and guidelines by allowing driveways to be five feet wider on properties developed with Accessory Dwelling Units, and will not result in any negative environmental impact. Additionally, the proposed minor zoning text amendment will not result in the construction of new structures.
