When planets are retrograde their power is subdued. When direct, we can feel their full force.

Hours after Wednesday's Libra new moon (13 degrees Libra), Pluto turns stationary direct at 24 degrees Capricorn (sign of government). Saturn follows, turning direct on Sunday at 7 degrees Aquarius, sign of the new era under the Aquarian new Laws & Principles.

Pluto is the planet of deep and unceasing transformation, Saturn, the planet of structure, discipline and restructuring. Pluto is power dynamics, control and domination (who is in control, who is playing the dominant role, Pluto asks?). Pluto in Capricorn points us to the role of government. What ways is our government allowing humanity

control or taking control away from the people? While retrograde, a searchlight shines on these questions. When direct, humanity, if awake, begins to take control of our own sovereignty.
