At the conclusion of the December 1, 2021 public hearing, the Planning Commission will make a recommendation regarding the proposed 2021-2029 Housing Element Update, and such recommendation will be forwarded to the City Council for their consideration at a public hearing (date yet to be determined).

Pursuant to California Government Code Sections § 65580 through § 65589.8, the City has undertaken an update of the Housing Element, which was last adopted in 2014. The Housing Element is one of seven state mandated General Plan Elements and it addresses issues related to existing and future housing needs of the community.

**Environmental Review Status:** Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and the City's Guidelines for the Implementation of CEQA, the City has reviewed and considered the Final Environmental Impact Report ("FEIR") for the General Plan certified by the City Council on September 28, 2016 (State Clearinghouse No. 2015121052), including the impacts and mitigation measures identified therein. In compliance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15164, an Addendum to the General Plan FEIR has been prepared which concludes that the proposed updates to the General Plan Housing Element do not result in any new or greater environmental impacts than were previously analyzed, disclosed, and mitigated. None of the conditions in CEQA Guidelines Section 15162 are present to require the preparation of a subsequent EIR, and no additional environmental review is required. The Addendum to the FEIR prepared for the proposed project will be included in the Planning Commission Agenda Package.

Comments regarding this project may be submitted in writing to the Planning Division prior to the public hearing, or may be made verbally at the public hearing (if you challenge this proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Westminster Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing). The Planning Commission's decision regarding the application will be final unless an appeal is submitted in writing within 15 days of the action.
