The Project, as proposed, is a 60-bed residential care facility on a property that is designated as "Public/Semi-Public Facilities" per the City's General Plan and is zoned P/SP "Public/Semi-Public." The Project will require a General Plan Amendment to change the land use designation to "Residential Medium Density (8.1 - 14.0 du/acre)" and a Zoning Map Amendment to change the zoning to "R3 (Multiple Family Residential (13 to 14 Units/Acre) District."
 The proposed care facility for the elderly will provide assisted living services for patients with Alzheimer's disease and other types of dementia. The facility will operate 24 hours per day, 7 days per week and will be served by three staggered daily staffing shifts. The facility will be staffed by approximately 50 employees. A Conditional Use Permit is required for the proposed land use.
 To accommodate the proposed care facility the Project also includes a proposed single-story, 26,680-square-foot building on a lot of 1.98 acres that is currently vacant. The site layout will include associated parking areas for employees and visitors to the facility, which will take access from two driveways on Heil Avenue. Landscaped courtyards and stormwater management facilities will be constructed. Runoff from new impervious areas on the site will be routed through three bio-filtration basins located across the project area. Ultimately the Project will drain into the East Garden Grove-Wintersburg Channel adjacent to the property. The Project will construct a storm sewer connection to an existing curb inlet in the Huntington Beach storm sewer located in Heil Avenue. The Project will also construct a sanitary sewer connection to an existing Huntington Beach sewer main south of Heil Avenue. A Development Review is required for the proposed building.
ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW STATUS
 An Initial Study (IS) and Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) were prepared for the above referenced project. **ORDINANCE NO. 71
SUMMARY FOR PUBLICATION**

**AMENDMENTS TO MIDWAY CITY SANITARY
DISTRICT SOLID WASTE REGULATIONS TO
COMPLY WITH SB 1383 ORGANICS RECYCLING
REGULATIONS**

EFFECTIVE ONE WEEK AFTER PUBLICATION

On December 7, 2021 the Board of Directors of the Midway City Sanitary District adopted Ordinance No. 71 amending its existing solid waste regulations to comply with Senate Bill (SB) 1383 and CalRecycle's SB 1383 Regulations mandating the recycling or organic waste including food waste.

Ordinance 71 restates and updates the District's existing solid waste regulations to incorporate and comply with requirements imposed pursuant to SB 1383 and the SB 1383 Regulations. The amendments to the existing regulations include (i) the addition and modification of defined terms to correspond to defined terms in the SB 1383 Regulations; (ii) the modification of the regulations governing self-haulers to require source separation and recycling of organic waste in compliance with the SB 1383 Regulations; (iii) the modification of provisions requiring generators to source separate their organic waste, recyclable materials, and non-recyclable solid waste for collection and disposal to comply with the SB 1383 Regulations; (iv) the addition of express authority for the General Manager to review and order adjustment of a generator's level of service to ensure adequate capacity is provided for each type of service (recyclable materials, organic waste, and non-recyclable solid waste); (v) the addition and modification of requirements on commercial businesses pertaining to source separating and recycling organic waste and recyclable waste consistent with requirements imposed pursuant to the SB 1383 Regulations; (vi) the addition of requirements and standards for haulers providing organic waste collection services to generators within the District's jurisdiction consistent with the SB 1383 Regulations; (vii) the addition of requirements for organic waste facility operators to provide specified information to the District; (viii) the addition of edible food recovery, inspection, and recordkeeping requirements for commercial edible food generators consistent with the SB 1383 Regulations; (ix) the addition of recordkeeping and reporting requirements for food recovery organizations and food recovery services operating within the District consistent with the SB 1383 Regulations; (x) the addition of express inspection and investigation authority by District representatives and designated entities to ensure compliance with the regulations; (xi) the addition of SB 1383 organic waste enforcement provisions and authority in accordance with requirements of the SB 1383 Regulations; and (xii) the addition of provisions for administrative citation enforcement of the regulations, including the establishment of fines in the amount of \$100 for a first violation, \$200 for a second violation within one year, and \$500 for each additional violation within one year.

The Housing Element is one of seven state mandated General Plan Elements and it addresses issues related to existing and future housing needs of the community.

Environmental Review Status: Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and the City's Guidelines for the Implementation of CEQA, the City has reviewed and considered the Final Environmental Impact Report ("FEIR") for the General Plan certified by the City Council on September 28, 2016 (State Clearinghouse No. 2015121052), including the impacts and mitigation measures identified therein. In compliance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15164, an Addendum to the General Plan FEIR has been prepared which concludes that the proposed updates to the General Plan Housing Element do not result in any new or greater environmental impacts than were previously analyzed, disclosed, and mitigated. None of the conditions in CEQA Guidelines Section 15162 are present to require the preparation of a subsequent EIR, and no additional environmental review is required.
