INFORMATION: *
Planning Commission

The Planning Commission shall have the power to adopt rules for the transaction of its business, subject to approval of the City Council, and such power and duties as are or may hereafter be specified by state law or resolution of the City Council in the following areas: area variances, conditional use permits, site plans, parcel maps, environmental impact reports and negative declarations, and zone changes.

Community Services and Recreation Commission
The Community Services and Recreation Commission is advisory to the City Council and their duties and responsibilities include: Advise Council on matters pertaining to the acquisition and development of parks, recreational, cultural and human service facilities; The beautification and improvement of the environment of the city; The promotion of cultural arts within the city; Plan and coordinate all activities and human service needs and programs for the community; Solicit to the fullest extent possible the cooperation of the school authorities and public and private agencies interested in youth program activities; and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the City Council.

The Commission is to hold at least six meetings per year or meet at the pleasure of the City Council. Each member of a commission may receive a stipend for each attendance at a regular or adjourned regular meeting, provided that compensation does not exceed a certain number of meetings per year, which may vary by commission.

Each member may be required to file Fair Political Practices Commission Form, Statement of Economic Interest (SEI - Form 700).
