The City must annually submit an Annual Action Plan (AAP) to the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), which specifies the activities that will be undertaken to meet the goals identified in the 2020/21 – 2024/25 Consolidated Plan. The AAP is due to HUD by May 17, 2022 and is subject to review and approval by HUD.

For fiscal year 2022/23, the City of Westminster will have an estimated total of \$2,717,860 in CDBG funds. This total amount is comprised of an estimated \$997,000 in Fiscal 2022/23 CDBG entitlement funds and \$1,720,860 in prior year unallocated CDBG funds carried forward. Carryover CDBG funds are due to project savings from subrecipients and capital improvement projects and program income. Actual allocations from HUD have not yet been published, although they are expected to be within +/-10% of FY 2021/22 funding levels.

The City of Westminster will have \$1,916,077 in HOME Program funds comprised of this coming year's allocation of \$445,517 (estimate based in 2021/22 funding level; funding levels for FY 2022/23 have yet to be published), and an estimated carryover balance of \$1,470,560.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) CDBG funds are designed to assist the City in its efforts to provide decent housing, a suitable living environment, community services and facility needs, and expand economic opportunities for primarily low-and-moderate income persons. The City may allocate a maximum of 15 percent of the annual CDBG entitlement to public service providers. Therefore, approximately \$149,550 is available to public service providers in FY 2022/23. The remainder of funds may be allocated to capital projects or capital improvements, and to administrative costs. providers in Projects or capital improvements, and to administrative costs which are limited to 20 percent. Funds remaining from prior projects completed under budget may be allocated to supplemental City-initiatec capital projects.
