**APPEAL OF PLANNING COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATIONS AND ACTIONS**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A REQUEST TO DEVELOP A 3.72-ACRE SITE WITH THE NICKELODEON HOTEL RESORT (COMMONLY KNOWN AS SITE B2 HOTEL PROJECT SITE). AS PART OF THE PROJECT, THE CITY COUNCIL WILL CONSIDER APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT NO. PUD 141 01 TO CREATE A NEW SUB-AREA, PUD 141 01(A), AND SITE PLAN NO.
