This ordinance makes a number of amendments to the Westminster Municipal Code, Title 2, relating to the rules governing Commissions, Boards, and Committees, and Title 10 relating to the Traffic Commission, as listed in the Ordinance title. The following are highlights of the proposed amendments.

- Add new Chapter 2.42 – General Rules Governing Commissions and Committee Appointments. It is proposed to add this new Chapter. This Chapter is more comprehensive update to the general rules currently found in Chapter 2.69, which is proposed to be deleted.

The new Chapter 2.42 covers a variety rules that will govern Commissions and Committees, including but not limited to the term of office, process and timing of the appointment of a Chair and Vice Chair, adopting rules for each body, the processing of applications, the process for nomination, appointment and removal, anti-nepotism rules, etc.

- Amend Chapter 2.44 – Planning Commission. Minor changes to be consistent with other commissions.

- Amend Chapter 2.56 – Community Services and Recreation Commission. This updates this Chapter including renaming this commission to be the “Parks and Recreation Commission,” eliminating 2 alternate positions, modifying the processes for appointments and removals.

- Delete Chapter 2.69 – Boards, Commissions, and Committees (Generally). It is proposed that this Chapter be deleted, in light of the new general rules adopted in the new Chapter 2.42.

- Update Chapter 10.12 – Traffic Commission. Proposed changes to this Chapter are regarding language to be consistent with other Commissions, concerning the provisions governing appointments of Chair and Vice Chapter.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 2.04.040 (MEETINGS - DISCUSSION - REFERRAL TO DEPARTMENTS) OF THE WESTMINSTER MUNICIPAL CODE RELATIVE TO ORAL COMMUNICATIONS AT COUNCIL MEETINGS

The City Council of the City of Westminster HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 2.04.040 Meetings - Discussion - Referral to departments of Title 2 (Administration and Personnel) of the Westminster Municipal Code is hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety with the following: Section 2.04.040 Meetings - Discussion - Referral to departments.

A. Oral communications from any person other than a city council member shall be limited to matters that are germane to city business. At the discretion of the presiding officer, any matter may be referred to a city department when in the presiding officer's opinion such matter could be more expeditiously handled by the appropriate city department. In order to ensure that those present wishing to address the city council may be given an equal opportunity to be heard, oral communications shall be limited to three minutes per person; however, by majority vote of the city council, this time limitation may be extended. B. Oral communications from any person other than a city council member shall not be received until the time for oral communications in the order of business.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, clause or phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3: The Interim City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published in the manner required by law. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from and after its passage.

SECTION 4: The Mayor shall sign as to the passage, approval, and adoption of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: The Interim City Clerk shall certify that the Mayor and City Council introduced and conducted first reading on the 11th day of January 2023. The Interim City Clerk further certifies that the Mayor and City Council at its Regular Meeting on the 25th day of January 2023, conducted second reading, passed, and adopted Ordinance No. 2599 and shall affix their signature and City Seal and that same shall be entered into the Book of Ordinances.
