The cash, check or bond will be declared forfeited if the successful bidder fails to enter into a contract and provide the necessary bonds and certificate of insurance within ten (10) days after notice to do so. Each bidder shall be a licensed contractor pursuant to the Business and Professions Code and shall be licensed in the following appropriate classification of contractor's license, A, B or C-12, for the work bid upon, and must maintain the license throughout the duration of the Contract. Time is of the essence. The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding process. The award of any contract, if made by the District, will be by the action of the Governing Board, to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder(s). Each bidder shall be a licensed contractor pursuant to the California Business and Professions Code, and be licensed to perform the work called for in the Project Documents. The successful bidder must possess a valid and active Class C12 and C8 License at the time of award and throughout the duration of the Contract. In accordance with California Public Contract Code section 22300, the District will permit the substitution of securities for any moneys withheld by the District to ensure performance under the Contract.

These per diem rates, including holiday and overtime work, as well as employer payments for health and welfare, pension, vacation, and similar purposes, are on file at the District, and are also available from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations. Pursuant to California Labor Code section 1720 et seq., it shall be mandatory upon the Contractor to whom the Contract is awarded, and upon any subcontractor under such Contractor, to pay not less than the said specified rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the Contract.
