ORDINANCE NO. 2973

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE ADDING CHAPTER 2.65 TO TITLE 2 OF THE GARDEN GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE ENACTING STANDARDS FOR PUBLIC HEARING NOTICES AND OTHER CITY COMMUNICATIONS.

City Attorney Summary

This Ordinance enacts standards for City communications with the public. The standards are intended to promote clarity in communications between the City and the community to support the City's open government policy. The ordinance adopts regulations requiring the use of simple language, using street addresses when available to describe physical locations in the City, defining acronyms before using them in text, using easily readable fonts and font sizes, numbering pages in print communications, and using a standard signature block for emails, letters and memoranda. The ordinance confirms the City's compliance with the requirements of the California Public Records Act. Finally, the ordinance prohibits communications that would feature an individual elected official or candidate for elective office within 120 days of any election and requires that no City communication be used to promote or oppose any elected official or candidate for elective office. The ordinance exempts and does not apply to: internal communications between City officials and City employees; communications between elected or appointed officials and the public; ordinances, resolutions official documents adopted or approved by the City Council at a public meeting, City Council and Commissions agendas and staff reports, utility bills, forms or correspondence required or modeled pursuant to Federal or State law and regulations, requests for proposals or qualifications, invitation for bids, contracts, applications and legal forms.
